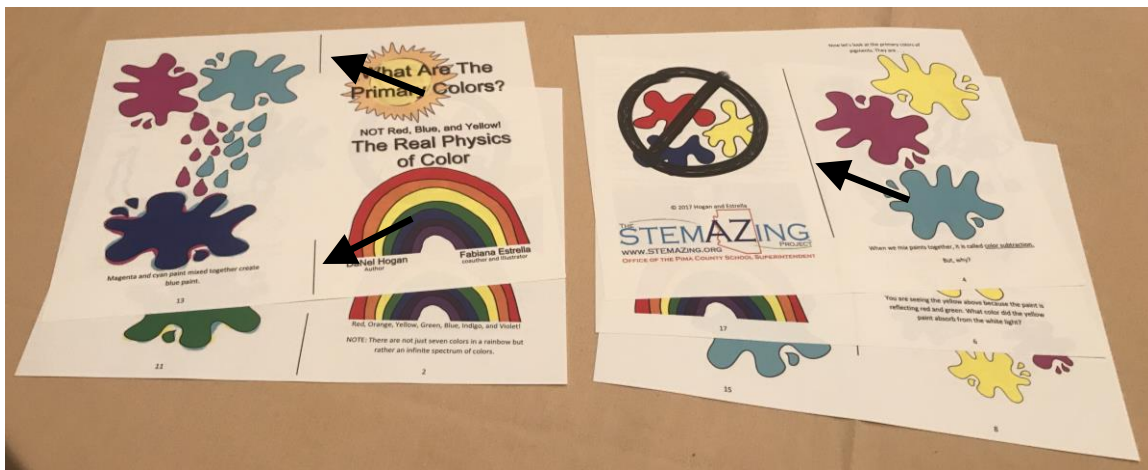


Assembly Directions for REAL Primary Colors Book

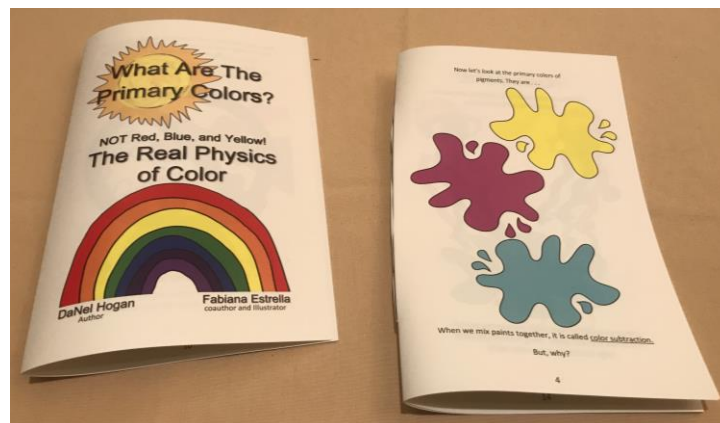
Print *What Are The Primary Colors?* book (<https://stemazing.org/real-primary-colors-book/>) double-sided and flipped along the SHORT edge. It is recommended you print the book on 9mm poly paper for durability but white cardstock also works.

Separate the five pages into the two sets shown below. The set on the left (two pages) has two lines at the midpoint while the set on the right (three pages) has one line at the midpoint down the middle of the page. Be sure to keep the pages in order.

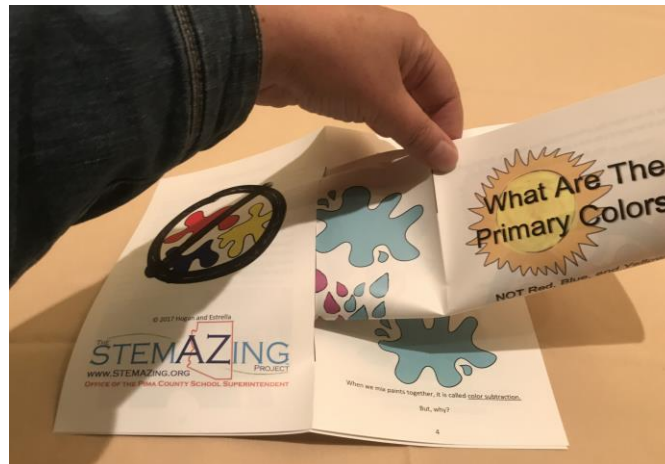


Cut the set on the left along the two lines, indicated with black arrows, starting from the edge of the paper. To cut the set on the right, you can either use a box cutter (recommended) or you can bend the pages in half lengthwise and cut along the line with scissors.

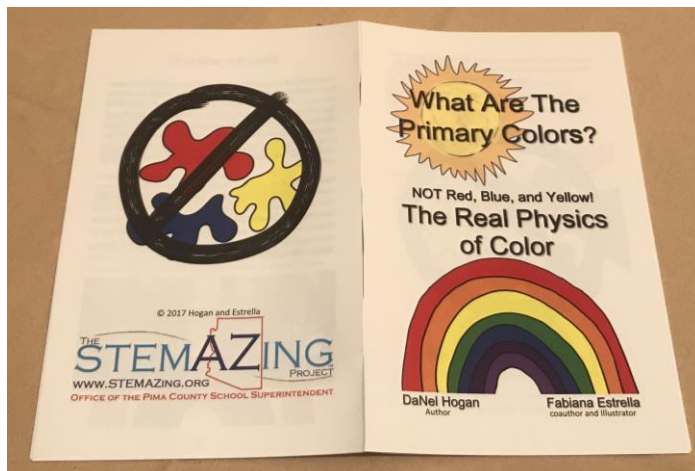
Once you have made your cuts to each set, fold each set in half, as shown below. Make sure to crease the fold of each set really well.



Next, lay the two halves flat again, as shown in the first picture, then bend the set of pages with the front cover on it in half. Then, nest the front cover set into the other set, as shown below. Be sure it is done exactly as shown so the page numbers will be correct when it is assembled.



Note the back cover and the front cover will be side-by-side, as shown on the left below, if you have put it together correctly. If not, take it apart and try again!



Finally, fold it in half and check the page numbers to ensure it has been assembled correctly. If not, take it apart and try again!

NOTE: If some of the pages are upside down, you may have printed it by flipping on the long edge instead of the short edge. You guessed it – print it again the right way!
