

# Number Grid Tic-Tac-Toe

## How to Play

1. Each player selects a colored marker or pencil to use and writes their name on the game board with that color.
2. Decide on a player to go first. They write a number anywhere on the board that corresponds to the number of the box from 1-100.
3. The next player puts a number anywhere they want on the board in a box that has not be claimed yet.
4. Play continues back and forth.
5. If a player is able to claim four boxes in their color either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally, they draw a line through those boxes to claim that Tic-Tac-Toe Four.
6. Play continues until all the numbers have been claimed.

**NOTE:** A number box can only be used once for a Tic-Tac-Toe.

## Winning the Game

The winner is the player with the most Tic-Tac-Toe Fours at the end of the game. These should be tallied below the players' names. This can either be done as you play or tallied at the end.

## Variations

The three-player version of the game is the same except the goal is to get Tic-Tac-Toe Threes.

Bonus points can be awarded for Tic-Tac-Toe strings longer than the goal. For instance, in the two-player game two points would be awarded for a Tic-Tac-Toe Five, three points for a Tic-Tac-Toe Six, and so on.

For younger children, a hundreds chart with the numbers on it which can either be colored in or traced can be used instead.
